**AN ACT Prohibiting Trapping in the Town of Scarboro and in the City
of Saco.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 72-B and to read as follows:

'Sec. 72-B. Trapping prohibited in town of Scarboro and in city of Saco; exceptions. Trapping for all animals is hereby prohibited in the town of Scarboro and in the city of Saco, in the counties of Cumberland and York, except that the provisions of this section shall not prohibit trapping on any of the salt marshes therein.'
