RESOLVE, Naming "Perleys Pond".

Perleys Pond; named. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation designating as "Perleys Pond" a certain pond, located in the town of Denmark, county of Oxford, on the east side of the Bridgton and Saco river railroad at a point called Perleys Mills.
