## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Naming the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Frank McGuire Memorial Bridge. That the bridge across Eggemoggin Reach, between the towns of Deer Isle and Sedgwick, is hereby designated and shall be forever known as "The Frank McGuire Memorial Bridge."
