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## S T A T E   O F   M A I N E

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### AN ACT Relating to the Livermore Falls Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1899, c. 120, § 13, amended.** Section 13 of chapter 120 of the private and special laws of 1899, as amended by section 1 of chapter 233 of the private and special laws of 1913, and by section 1 of chapter 73 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 13. Fees; salary.** All fees, civil and criminal, shall inure to the county of Androscoggin and shall be paid over to the treasurer of said county by said judge on the 1st day of each month. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of ~~six hundred dollars~~ \$1000 in full for all services, payable quarterly, on the 1st days of April, July, October and January from the treasury of Androscoggin county.'
