STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Lewiston Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 128, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 128 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended by chapter 23 of the private and special laws of 1923, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Amount allowed for clerk hire increased. The clerk of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of \$1800, with ten hundred and forty dollars \$1200 additional for clerk hire from said city in monthly payments, which sum shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of said clerk by law. He shall account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year, to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston for all fees received by him by virtue of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston, quarterly on the days aforesaid.'
