STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Lighting Mount Desert Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Lights to be maintained. The towns of Bar Harbor, Southwest Harbor, Mount Desert, Trenton and Tremont, in the county of Hancock, are hereby authorized to maintain a proper lighting system on Mount Desert Bridge, so-called. Each of said towns shall contribute the same per cent of the total cost as formerly paid by said towns in operating the Mount Desert Bridge District.
- Sec. 2. Authority to raise and appropriate money. The said towns hereby are authorized to raise by taxation and appropriate such sums of money as are needed for the accomplishment of the purpose mentioned in section I hereof.
