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### **AN ACT Relating to Source of Water Supply for Veterans' Administration Facility.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Source of water supply.** The Veterans' Administration which carries on the Veterans' Administration Facility at Togus, in the town of Chelsea, in the county of Kennebec, is hereby authorized to take, hold, divert, use, and distribute water from Lower Togus Pond or Stream, so-called, for the purpose of supplying water for use at said Facility.

**Sec. 2. Authority to cross under highways when necessary.** The mains and pipes conveying said water from said pond to said Facility to be laid on or in the land belonging to the Veterans' Administration and authority is hereby granted to cross under any highways necessary in the premises at the expense of said Veterans' Administration.

**Sec. 3. Contracts and agreements.** The Veterans' Administration is granted authority to construct and do the necessary things and acts at and in said pond to facilitate the purposes of this act and shall have authority to enter such contracts or agreements as it may find advisable to carry out the purposes of this act.
