RESOLVE, For the Purchase of Five Hundred Copies of "Vital Statistics of Georgetown."

Purchase of "Vital Statistics of Georgetown", authorized. Resolved: That the state librarian be and is hereby authorized and directed to purchase 500 copies of "Vital Statistics of Georgetown"; and that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$3,000 for the purchase of said 500 copies to be paid from the general funds of the state to Mary Pelham Hill of Topsham, who, under the authorization of the state librarian, compiled said "Vital Statistics of Georgetown."

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On August 17, 1937, the state librarian, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 4, section 9, of the revised statutes of 1930, and the amendments thereto, authorized the standing committee of the Maine Historical Society, Portland, Maine, to have compiled and printed the "Vital Statistics of Georgetown, Maine." Under such authorization Mary Pelham Hill was employed to compile said vital statistics which work she has, with a great amount of labor and effort, completed, and said statistics are now ready for printing.
