IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT in Regard to Service of Writs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Service of writs. Writs in civil actions in the superior court shall be served 30 days before the return day and shall be in order for trial at the first term.
