**AN ACT in Regard to New Trials on the Ground of Newly Discovered
Evidence.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Motions for new trials may be presented. Motions for new trials on the ground of newly discovered evidence in both civil and criminal matters may be presented after as well as before judgment. This act shall apply in cases in which judgment has already been rendered.
