STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Transportation to Canneries of the Products of Vining and Cutting Plants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1937, c. 208, amended. Chapter 208 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby amended by adding after the word "canneries" in the 3rd line of paragraph numbered (3) of said chapter the words: 'and transportation to canneries of the products of vining and cutting plants'
