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**AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to the Width of Motor Vehicles.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 15, amended.** Section 15 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 15. Height and width of motor vehicles and trailers limited.** No motor vehicle or trailer which, with or without load, is wider than 8 feet over all, or is over 12 feet, 6 inches high, shall be operated upon any way or bridge. No portion of any such vehicle or load, except the reflecting mirror required by this chapter, shall project beyond the side of said vehicle to make a total width greater than herein specified. **Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to snow plows and equipment used exclusively for the removal of snow, or to construction equipment, the use of which is confined to the limits of highway and bridge construction projects.'**
