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**RESOLVE, Granting a Bonus to Albert Arthur Pouliotte.**

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**Albert Arthur Pouliotte; bonus provided for. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$100 to be paid to Albert Arthur Pouliotte of Waterville, as his World War bonus; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Albert Arthur Pouliotte a resident of Waterville enlisted in the United States Navy on July 22, 1918, and received his ordinary discharge at Boston, Mass. on February 17, 1919. He did not apply for his bonus within the time originally provided.
