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**AN ACT** Relating to Minimum Standards for Schools of Nursing Accredited in Maine.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 21, § 20, amended.** Paragraph (c) of section 20 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that said paragraph (c) shall read as follows:

‘(c) Has taken a full course of not less than 2 years in the same school of nursing from which he or she has graduated and received a diploma, said school of nursing to be one approved by the board of registration, and presided over by a nurse registered in accordance with the requirements of sections 18 to 24 inclusive, **provided, however, in case of transfer of a student nurse from an accredited school of nursing because of closing of the school of nursing the minimum time that the candidate may spend in the school of nursing from which she receives her diploma shall be one year.**’
