S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Trapping and Hunting Fur-bearing Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Unlawful to trap and hunt fur-bearing animals. No person shall at any time hunt or trap any fur-bearing animal on Number 3 pond located in the town of Lee and in township No. 3, range 1 north of the Bingham and Penobscot Purchase nor on any stream flowing into said pond.

Sec. 2. Penalty. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall be subject to the same penalties provided under section 107 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised.
