IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Waterfowl on Number 3 Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Unlawful to hunt waterfowl on Number 3 pond. No person shall at any time hunt any waterfowl on Number 3 pond located in the town of Lee and in township No. 3, range 1, north of the Bingham and Penobscot Purchase.

Sec. 2. Penalty. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall be subject to the same penalties provided under section 107 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised.
