RESOLVE, Opening Macwahoc Stream to Ice Fishing.

Macwahoc stream, opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing, Macwahoc stream from Reed Dam north to head of Clay dead water, located in townships 1, R. 4 and 2, R. 4.
