RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Moosehead Lake.

Fishing in Moosehead Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing the daily bag limit on fish taken from Moosehead Lake to 10 pounds per person per day.
