RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Pond.

Fishing in Little pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Little pond in Damariscotta, in the county of Lincoln, to all fishing from September 30th to the 1st day of April each year.
