STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Excavations in City Streets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 125, amended. Section 125 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'After the applicant shall have paid for the permit as provided in section 121, and shall have properly refilled the excavations as required by sections 123 and 124, the city shall thereupon assume all further liability for such excavations and the relaying of the pavement subject, however, to the limitations, notice and other provisions of section 94 to 97, inclusive, of this chapter.'
