## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Malt Liquors within a Radius of 500 Feet of a Gasoline Filling Station.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Retail licenses. Licenses for sale and distribution at retail under such regulations as the state liquor commission may prescribe may be issued by the state liquor commission upon an application in such form as may be prescribed by said commission and upon payment of a fee as hereinafter provided. No license for such sale shall be granted to any gasoline filling station nor to any premises within a radius of 500 feet of a gasoline filling station, except such premises as are holding licenses for the sale of vinous and spirituous liquors at the effective date of this act. No person, firm or corporation licensed to sell at retail shall sell malt beverages liquors for consumption on the premises where sold except as hereinafter provided.'
