STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Regulate the Use of Public Ways by Pedestrians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Use of public ways by pedestrians. All pedestrians traveling upon any public way shall walk on the left side of said way in the direction they are proceeding. Failure to so travel along any public way shall be considered prima facie evidence of negligence on the part of such pedestrian, in the case of any accident.
