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AN ACT Concerning the Practice of Podiatry.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1933, c. 140, § 5, amended.** Section 5 of chapter 140 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

‘Because of illness and other good reasons for not filing his application to practice podiatry under this chapter, the application of Fred H. Lowell, of Bangor, Maine, to practice hereunder may be filed as hereinbefore provided within 1 year from the taking effect of this amendment, as a person who had been actively engaged in the practice of podiatry in this state for at least 2 years immediately prior to the taking effect of said chapter.’
