AN ACT Prohibiting the Employment of Females in Beer Establishments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, additional. Chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 18-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. Employment of females in beer establishments, prohibited. No female shall be employed, permitted or suffered to work in, about, or in connection with any place of business, including restaurants, grills and cafes where the principal business thereof is the dispensing of beer.'
