AN ACT Establishing a Game Preserve and Sanctuary in Yarmouth, in  
Cumberland County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph thereof the following:

‘Lanes Island: the following described territory, known as Lanes Island, situate in the town of Yarmouth, Cumberland county, and bounded as follows: Northerly, easterly, westerly and southerly by the waters of the Atlantic ocean, and lying about 1 mile easterly from the mouth of Yarmouth or Royal river and about ½ mile from the shore of South Freeport.’
