**RESOLVE, Authorizing Charles A. Darrington to Bring Suit at Law
against the State of Maine.**

Charles A. Darrington, authorized to bring suit. Resolved: That Charles A. Darrington, of Canton, in the county of Oxford, claiming that he was employed to strip a gravel pit, for which he has not been compensated, is hereby authorized to bring a suit at law in the superior court within 1 year from the 1st day of August, 1939, at any term thereof for the county of Oxford, against the state of Maine, and the writ issuing out of said superior court shall be served on the secretary of state by attested copy 30 days at least before the return day thereof by the sheriff, or either of his deputies, of any county of the state of Maine, and the cause may be heard before a single justice or before a jury of Oxford county, as may be determined by the parties to said suit and the court, and the liabilities of the parties shall be the same as the liabilities between individuals, and any judgment that may be recovered in such suit shall be payable from the treasury of the state of Maine on final process issued by said superior court in said suit at law out of any money not otherwise appropriated and costs may be taxed for said Darrington if he recovers in said suit.
