## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell Land on Muscongus Island.

Forest commissioner authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell and convey to The First National Bank, of Damariscotta, a I acre and 3 acre lots of land with buildings thereon, on Muscongus Island (Loudville), Lincoln county, for the amount due to the state for taxes and costs.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land, reputed to be owned by Mary Carter of Round Pond, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1930 for 1928 taxes. The First National Bank is desirous of obtaining these lots by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to April 1, 1939 amount to \$123.51. Check for this amount is in the hands of the state tax assessor.
