IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Exemption of Estates from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IV, amended. Paragraph IV of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘IV. The household furniture of each person, not exceeding \$500 to any one ~~family~~ **household**, his wearing apparel, farming utensils **to the value of \$500**, mechanics’ tools **to the value of \$200** necessary for his business, and musical instruments not exceeding in value \$50 to one family.’
