**AN ACT Relative to Operation of Motor Vehicles for Transporting
Property for Hire.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 146, § 10, ¶ (B), amended. Paragraph (B) of section 10 of chapter 146 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(B) **Rate exemptions.** There shall be exempted from the foregoing provisions as to rate regulation the transportation by motor vehicle of property (1) when moving in interstate commerce, (2) when moving to warehouses, railroads or boats for re-shipment by rail or vessel, and (3) when consisting of logs, wood or lumber moving to mills for manufacture, (4) fertilizer when moving from warehouse or factory within this state to the farm or consumer, (5) horses and cattle when being transported to agricultural fairs or horse and cattle shows within the state for exhibition purposes.’
