IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Houghton-Oquossoc Road.

Houghton-Oquossoc road; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940, for construction of the road beginning at Houghton and ending in Oquossoc. Said funds shall be taken from the general highway fund and expended under the supervision of the state highway commission. Any unexpended balance at the end of the aforesaid fiscal year shall be available for use during the next fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is to continue the building of this important road. In its unfinished condition, it serves poorly the heavy travel which must pass over it.
