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**RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Mexico for Support of Joseph and  
Rosario Rossi.**

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**Town of Mexico; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2871.54 to be paid to the town of Mexico to reimburse said town for the board and care of Joseph and Rosario Rossi, who have no settlement within the state; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The sum of \$2,871.54 is the amount paid by the town of Mexico, in error, to the account of the Rossi children. The state should have assumed the entire burden on these children as they had no settlement within the confines of Maine.
