## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fish Pounds or Traps Used in Fishing for Salmon in Penobscot River and Bay.

Use of fish pounds or traps in certain waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation providing that the netting of all fish pounds or traps used in fishing for salmon in Penobscot river and bay shall be removed and taken ashore within 72 hours after July 15th.
