STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide Inspection of Corn for Canning.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Department of agriculture to inspect the sampling of corn. The department of agriculture shall cause to be inspected the "sampling" of corn in all corn factories at least twice per week during the corn packing season.
