STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Insurance Policy Forms and Endorsements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Insurance companies to file policy forms and endorsements for approval. Every insurance company doing business in this state shall file with the insurance commissioner within 30 days of the effective date of this act all policy forms and endorsements to be used, in such form and with such detail as the insurance commissioner may order. The commissioner shall, within 30 days after such documents have been filed with him, approve or disapprove such forms and endorsements. No insurance company shall thereafter issue within this state any policy form or endorsement which has not been approved as provided in this act, and unless the commissioner otherwise orders no change shall be made in any policy form or endorsement which shall have been filed and approved as hereinbefore provided, except after 30 days' notice to the commissioner and except as such change may be approved by him.
