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## S T A T E O F M A I N E

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**AN ACT Amending the Old Age Assistance Law Relating to Funeral Expenses.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, Title II, c. 105, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 8. **Funeral expenses of person assisted.** On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$100 shall be paid by the state if the estate of the deceased **or insurance on his life** is insufficient to pay the same.'
