## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relative to Non-Resident Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 19, amended.** Paragraph (3) of section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Non-resident fishing licenses shall be of 3 classes, a month 15 day license to cost \$3.15, effective for 30 15 days from the date of purchase thereof, and a season license effective for the entire season, to cost \$5.15, but the amount paid for a month 15 day license shall be credited on the purchase of a year license upon an additional payment of \$2.15, also a junior non-resident license, which shall be a season license covering all non-residents, between the ages of 10 and 16 years, to cost \$1.15. Fifteen cents shall be retained by the agent for each license issued.'
