RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Sebago Lake.

Fishing in Sebago lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, opening Sebago lake in the county of Cumberland, to ice fishing for white fish with general law bag limit of 10 pounds per person per day.
