**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Trickey Pond in Naples.**

---

**Fishing in Trickey Pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Trickey Pond, in Naples, to bait casting, trolling, and fly fishing from the time the ice goes out in the spring until all ponds are closed by the general law, to all fish therein; provided, however, that there shall be a daily bag limit of 3 fish per person per day, and provided, further, that there shall be a limit of 5 fish per day for the occupants of any one boat.
