RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Fourth Buttermilk Pond.

Fishing in Fourth Buttermilk pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Fourth Buttermilk pond in Piscataquis county to ice fishing and establishing a bag limit for fishing in open water of 10 pounds per person per day.
