**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Somerset County Waters.**

---

**Fishing in certain Somerset county waters, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all except fly fishing with a daily bag limit of 4 fish per person per day the following named ponds in the county of Somerset: High Pond, Helen Pond, Higher Pond, Fish Pond, Grass Pond, Split Rock Pond, all in Pierce Pond Town and King Pond and Kilgore Pond in Bowtown and Pierce Pond town.
