AN ACT Relating to Municipal Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 136, amended. Section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be numbered XVII, and to read as follows:

‘XVII. Towns and cities may establish and adopt by-laws and ordinances for the purposes of: regulating and controlling the speed and use of motor boats and aircraft upon the waters of the lakes and towns within such municipalities; and suitable penalties may be provided in such by-laws and ordinances.’
