STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 13, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. Personal estate taxable. Personal estate for the purposes of taxation, includes all goods, chattels, moneys, and effects, wheresoever they are; all vessels, at home or abroad; all obligations for money or other property; money at interest, and debts due the persons to be taxed more than they are owing; all public stocks and securities; all shares in moneyed and other corporations within or without the state, except as otherwise provided by law; and all annuities payable to the person to be taxed, when the capital of such annuity is not taxed in this state; and all other property, included in the last preceding state valuation for the purposes of taxation.'
