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**AN ACT Relative to Game Preserve in Hancock County.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 90, amended.** Section 90 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following:

‘No person shall, except as herein provided, at any time hunt, pursue, shoot at, molest or kill any wild animal or wild bird, within the following described territory in Stonington in the county of Hancock: bounded on the west by the Sunset road (U. S. No. 2) to Deer Isle; on the north by the old Winter road from Sunset to Long Cove; on the east by the main road to Deer Isle; and on the south by the upper Southeast Crossroad.

The provisions of this act shall not prohibit the commissioner of inland fisheries and game from regulating the taking of fur-bearing animals thereon.’
