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### AN ACT Relative to Fishing in Fishways.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 20, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 20, and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 20. Closing fishways to fishing. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish in, or within 150 feet of any fishway.’
