AN ACT Relating to Practice of Law by Judges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Practice of law by municipal court judges, regulated. Any action in which the judge of any municipal court, or the clerk or recorder thereof, may be interested, either by relationship, as counsel or otherwise, may be brought by such judge, clerk or recorder, if he is an attorney at law, before any other court, superior or municipal, in the same county in the same manner and with like effect as other actions therein and they are authorized to practice law in all other courts in the state in both civil and criminal matters.
