AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 31, amended. Section 31 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 31. The public utilities commission. The annual salary of each member of the public utilities commission shall be ~~six thousand dollars~~ **\$4000**. The salary of subordinate officials and employees of said commission shall be left to the discretion of the public utilities commission, subject to approval of the governor and council; the commissioners and all employees shall receive actual expenses when traveling on official business.'
