IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Records of Sales of Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Records of sales of lobsters. Whoever buys lobsters in excess of 50 pounds at one time shall record the license number of the seller and shall keep such record for 1 year which record shall be available for the inspection of any warden of the department of sea and shore fisheries.
