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**RESOLVE, Relative to Protection of Smelts in Medomak River.**

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**Smelts in Medomak river protected. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal the first paragraph of rule and regulation number 87 as issued by the commission and published in 1937 and to issue the following in place thereof:

‘All persons are hereby prohibited from taking any smelts from Medomak river in the county of Lincoln above a line drawn from the southern end of Havener’s Point in the town of Waldoboro easterly to the northerly end of Jones’ Neck in said town of Waldoboro, by means of weirs, drag-nets, traps or other contrivance than hook and line and dip net.’
