AN ACT Relating to Payment of Damages Done to Sheep and Lambs by
Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 166, amended. Section 166 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 50 of the public laws of 1931, and by section 1 of chapter 202 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby amended so that the 5th paragraph of said section shall read as follows:

‘The commissioner of agriculture or his duly authorized agent shall approve the bill, or if it seems advisable, investigate and adjust the claim, but no payment for sheep or lambs injured, maimed or killed by dogs, shall exceed \$20 for each unregistered sheep or lamb, or \$35 for each registered sheep or lamb.’
