S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Retirement of the 1936-1937 Deficit. .

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1937, c. 15, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended by section 1 of Title I of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937, passed at the special session held October 26 to 29, 1937, is hereby further amended as follows :

'Sec. 5. Disposition of monies collected. All money received by the state liquor commission under this act shall be forthwith turned over to the state treasurer. From such money so turned over to the state treasurer beginning on June 30, 1938, there shall be credited the sum of \$495,345.79 ~~annually to and including June 30, 1941,~~ and thereafter the **sum of \$100,000 annually** to the account entitled "1937 deficiency account" on the books of the state controller **until the said "1937 deficiency account" shall be entirely canceled.** All other money so turned over to the state treasurer shall remain in the general funds of the state.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1937, c. 15, § 8, repealed. Section 8 of chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended by section 2 of Title I of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937, passed at the special session held October 26 to 29, 1937, is hereby repealed.
